CLBC ANNUAL TRIPLES TOURNAMENT

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Maximum number of entries is 16 teams. This tournament is planned as an open triples one day event. An even number of entries will be accepted to avoid byes. Teams are placed in sections by random draw.
2. Each Team will play three games, maximum duration of two hours each game. Games will be 12 ends. Dead ends count as played ends except for the last end. If the last end is dead, it must be replayed.
3. There are no trial ends. Start time for the first game is 9:00 a.m. A bell will be rung at the start of the game and at half-time. A warning bell will be rung 5 minutes before the game ends. If an end has been started before the warning bell, it may be finished. An end is considered started if the jack has been delivered properly.
4. Order for opening play is determined by either the toss of a coin or the roll of a bowl.
5. Skips only are allowed to walk up to the head after delivery of each of their bowls.
6. Skips must sign completed scorecards and return them to the umpire immediately after the game.
7. Scoring is as follows: Win - 6 points; Tie - 3 points; End - 1 point
The winning team can score a differential up to a maximum of five (5) points.

A team's final ranking is based on: (a) wins/ties, and, (b) points won for the three games.

Ties are broken as follows: (a) result of head-to-head play
(b) differential
(c) most ends won
(d) skips deliver one bowl to a maximum-length jack, closest wins

8. There will be no playoffs. The top four teams overall will receive cash prizes.
9. A Light Lunch is provided for all competitors and officials following the second game.
10. The Tournament Committee shall appoint a Head Umpire for the event.
